Purchase your **Christmas trees, wreaths, window swags and garland** at the Penn Street Market in December. The open-air farmers market is located across from the Manor at Market Square.

On **Friday, December 7th and 14th**, local farmer **Jeremy Freymoyer**, will be selling Douglas Fir and Fraser Fir trees cut from their 20-acres of Christmas trees, located at the base of the Blue Mountain in Upper Bern/Tilden Twps. The Freymoyer Farm is a fourth-generation tree farm. Trees will range from 3' to 8', with prices starting at \$15. Customers can order larger trees or different species by calling the farm at 610-301-1829. Market hours will be from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Other Penn Street market vendors who will be participating in the Holiday Market are: **Griesemer Beekeeping** selling honey products; **PerkUp Truck**, selling delicious hot and cold drinks and desserts; **Lally's Cake Creations** selling cupcakes and assorted baked goods, and canine treats; **Chapman's Deli** (12/7) and **Callowhill Café** (12/14) serving lunch menu items.
